#### \*\*\* 2022 Financial Notes:

- Dues collections are basically on budget. Currently, only 10 remaining to collect, which is about average.
- We expect to come in under budget in the weed treatment line by approximately \$22,000.
- We've spent much of the required funds towards the new electronic gate at the ramp, and are pleased to say we have come in under budget. The automatic gate process seems to be working well with only a few minor hiccups.
- With the savings in the other "Lakes" items, we can cover the **required** overage that EGLE has imposed upon us in regards to the new seawall around Skiers Island and still be within our budget. In order to move forward with the installation, we had to agree to comply with several add-ons.
- Regarding the Water Quality project that was approved for the 2022 budget for \$47,000, there has been similar challenges with getting a permit from EGLE. At this point, we are forecasting the expense at the budgeted amount, but this could change as we work through the process

#### \*\*\* 2023 Proposed Budget Notes:

After much discussion amongst the Board members, the Board voted to hold the PROPOSED 2023 annual dues at \$400. This will be discussed at the October General Membership meeting and voted on by all members. Please attend and let us know your thoughts.

- One of the larger items in our budget is the weed treatment for the lake, and we anticipate that we can hold that at the same budgeted amount as 2022
- The boat ramp electronic gate will have annual expenses that should be much less than using a manned administrator. Utilities and some potential repairs are all that we expect moving forward.
- As mentioned above, the water quality issue has been delayed somewhat. Once the committee knows what EGLE requires, we can move forward. As of the writing of the report, we aren't budgeting any additional dollars in 2023. We hope to be able to discuss more thoroughly at the October General Membership meeting.
- The cost of fireworks has jumped sharply over the last coulee years, but with this being our single largest attended Social event, we felt that we still get great value and enjoyment for the cost.
- Several of the docks and poles at the islands are in need of repair and replacement for safety reasons. This expenditure is estimated at \$8,000 and should last for many years.
- + We expect to have unencumbered cash of approximately \$468,000 at 12/31/22.

The Skier's Island seawall rebuild is in progress and is about 50% complete as I write this article. This has been a long time coming (2.5 years +) and we are fortunate that it is



Don't - Share your card with anyone.

Don't - Attempt to override the gate's operation.

Don't - Hesitate to call a member of the boat ramp team in advance if you lack confidence or are unsure about any part of the launch process.

Don't - Be intimidated as the cameras are rolling and recording everything.

## Featured Jeighbor

Over the years countless volunteers have worked on the many different projects that have shaped Lake Sherwood as we know it today. This year there was a milestone accomplishment: Electronic Boat Ramp Access.



Although many of our wonderful neighbors were involved in this endeavor, LSA resident Todd Wood took the lead in this undertaking because of his technological expertise.

Todd has been an LSA resident since 2016 when he relocated to Lake Sherwood from White lake with his wife Amy and rescue Weimaraner Charlie. Todd had played an active role in his previous lake association so we were lucky he brought his knowledge and skills to our lake. Todd was serving as an Area Rep when it was announced Phyllis was retiring from her long tenure of Boat Ramp Administer. Todd joined a team of LSA volunteers, The Boat Ramp Committee, which explored options for access to our lake. Although the "manned gate option" had operated successfully for so many years, the committee decided that a digital option would better meets the needs of the community. To quote Todd, "We weren't going to find another Phyllis" and hiring a private security company

proved costly and logistically complicated.

Once the project was underway Todd and everyone encountered a major hurdle: making sure the gate stayed open to provide adequate launch time. Todd worked with the volunteers who determined that installing additional safety sensors would solve the problem. Other setbacks included availability of the necessary equipment, coordinating power needs with DTE and scheduling construction around winter

weather. While Todd's team worked through the installation, over 600 boats were manually launched by a team of on call volunteers.

Todd and the team of volunteers were able to complete the project for much less than the budgeted amount in addition to the long term savings to the association. Residents are able to launch 7 days a week on demand. The gate is secure with 24 hour camera monitoring that records the MC number of every boat launched. Each time a resident uses their card the security system saves the card number and time when it was used. Todd explained the only potential drawback to the new system would be damage to the equipment.

We are truly fortunate for Todd and all of the volunteers who contributed countless hours towards this endeavor. It wasn't easy, but their efforts will be appreciated by every one of us each time we launch or pull our boats from the lake.

Who's catching fish? The spring and summer have proved successful for many Lake Sherwood anglers. Bass remain the dominant species and the species most residents target. Proven tactics include jigs, crank baits and spinner baits. Lots of fish for many, but not seeing or hearing about many 20+" fish.

Pike numbers are down. I feel at this time we are at a healthy quantity of pike. Several big fish have been reported with several achieving that 40" benchmark.

Crappies are schooling fish. Often times find one, you can catch more. In the last 2 years I have bested my personal best a couple times with a 15 1/4" beast now at the top of my list.

Bluegills most likely make up the biggest population of fish in our lake. We caught lots while doing the fish survey last year. Unfortunately, most are smaller fish. I am not hearing or seeing enough decent size gills being caught. This was very evident in the last couple years while ice fishing. Hopefully this year will see that trend reverse with the reduction of smaller pike.

Walleyes are the only fish we've stocked in the last dozen plus years. Walleyes are not abundant but do offer some real excitement when hooked. It is our intent to once again stock walleyes this fall. This has proved to be a great event for families with kids carrying buckets of fish to the water's edge. Details to follow.

Carp are definitely making a comeback. I am seeing more and more over the last several years. The long time residents will remember the large scale carp die off that occurred about 20 years ago due to a viral kidney infection. Carp are often the fish many residents see jumping and splashing especially in the early summer timeframe. They are generally considered a rough species and undesirable.

Perch numbers are down. Small fish were netted during the survey, but not many big ones. Again, hoping the pike reduction will eventually help the perch population recover.

Enjoy our great fishery, but continue to value the resource. Release fish carefully and only keep a few for an occasional meal.

As always feel free to contact me regarding anything Lake Sherwood fishing related.

Hello All,

I wanted to once again share the LSA Ice Fishing Pass process. This is old news for many, but for those that are new or don't know, I have copied the process below. This process is now approaching ten years old and I have issued over 60 passes since its inception. It has very much helped in curtailing unauthorized fishermen. I very much welcome our collective effort in enforcing compliance as you are out on the ice. If anyone needs a pass, please give me a call on 248 255-7207.

Ice access for recreational purposes is restricted to Lake Sherwood residents and their guests. A Lake Sherwood resident must accompany any guest who is on the ice to fish. (We are willing to make exceptions to this rule if a resident is physically unable to accompany the guest.) Any Lake Sherwood resident who wishes to ice fish, or who has guests who wish to ice fish, must be in possession of an Access Pass. Any Lake Sherwood resident using an A-Lot to access the Lake must display a Lake Sherwood Parking Sticker in their vehicle in the vicinity of the driver's field of view. The Access Pass and Parking Sticker will be provided and controlled by the Lake Sherwood Fisheries Manager, Dan Devine, or his/her designate. Each Access Pass will identify the specific property owner and contact information. The Access Pass will allow lake access for ice fishing to the resident and up to four guests via a Lake Sherwood Association A-lot or the resident's property. If additional guests are invited to be on the ice to fish, a call to the Fisheries Manager Dan Devine or his/her designate in advance is required. If approached by any Lake Sherwood resident, the fisherman must show (or identify the resident they are fishing with) this Access Pass and identify those in his/her party. If the resident requires an Access Pass or Vehicle Pass, it is the responsibility of the Lake Sherwood resident to request this from the Lake Sherwood Fisheries Director or his/her designate. A Lake Sherwood resident granting ice access to guests for any purpose will be held responsible for the conduct and actions of their guests. If guests are in violation of any rules or regulations set forth by the Lake Sherwood Association or the State of Michigan, they will be asked to leave the lake property and the resident's Access Pass, if any, will be revoked. The Sheriff may also be requested to intervene. Access Passes for ice fishing will be issued only to those residents who are current with Lake Sherwood dues. If a resident loses the Access Pass or Parking Pass, they will be issued a replacement pass at a cost determined by the Lake Sherwood Association Board.



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
