

Reminders

Allow two weeks for your dues payment to be processed until your access card is activated.

Reach out to the boat ramp committee to register any new watercraft to ensure your card is activated and you aren't flagged for a violation by launching an unregistered boat

Never use your access card for your friends or neighbors, as you aren't able to be sure if their dues have been paid or if they are a member in good standing.

Always make sure the gate closes completely after each use. The quickest way to do this is to use the Close Gate button, located on the south side (right) of the ramp on the LSA sign post.

New users must fill out, sign and return the User Agreement and provide proof of ownership of their watercraft. The User Agreement can be found on the Lake Sherwood website.

If you have any questions, or have problems while using the gate, please contact a committee member listed above.

Always check the bulletin board for any new announcements or notices about the ramp.

*** 2024 Financial Notes:

- The DUES INVOICE & SURVEY HAVE BEEN MAILED AND ARE NOW DUE! (a copy is in this VIEW) Please be sure your \$400 is paid timely. Be mindful that if you are paying electronically that you also pay the applicable fee in addition to your Dues.
- We've collected Dues from about 75% of the membership. Thank You to all those that have paid and we look forwrad to collecting from everyone. This is imperative to keep the Association running smoothly.
- As mentioned in prior correspondence, the due date before the \$50 late fee is applied, is March 15, 2024
- Also of note, you won't have access to use the boat ramp if your Dues are not paid. PLEASE allow ample time for us to process your payment, and the Ramp Committee to get your ramp access activated.
- Because we are so seasonal, we have not spent a great deal of money towards the 2024 expense items.
- The largest expenditure to date is for the fireworks. We pay a 50% deposit to hold our preferred date as well as lock in pricing on the display shells.
- + We currently have unencumbered cash of approximately \$590,000 at 2/29/24.

*** 2024 Approved Budget Notes. (As presented and voted on at the Annual Membership Meeting in October.)

- The Board recommended holding the 2024 annual dues at \$400, and the membership approved at the October Annual meeting. This - would result in a small amount of Net Income, but there is always a chance of overruns given the complexities and age of the subdivision.
- One of the larger items in our budget every year is the weed treatment for the lake, and we anticipate that we can hold that at the - same amount as the 2023 budget. This line will also be used for the Eutrosorb bag concept that was implemented in 2023, and Phragmite eradication if needed.
- The Water Quality / Wildwood River issue is still delayed. Once we satisfy what EGLE requires and obtain a permit, we can move forward. Due to the uncertainty surrounding this project, we aren't budgeting any additional dollars in 2024, but we are going to implement some new concepts to help contain the problem (ie: the Bio-Health Pod System). As noted above, there is a reserve already for this, but we may need to request additional funding if the project scope or pricing changes.
- The Beautification line has a new amount to improve the look of the Surfwood isthmus that faces both the lake and the ramp bay.
 There is a newly formed Island Committee that began in 2023. This group has presented the Board with a 5-year plan to maintain and improve the various islande. In the net or disturb the will include accurate the various islande in accord. Although there is
 - improve the various islands. In the not so distant future, this will include seawall replacement at the islands in need. Although there is not a proposed budget for all 5 years, there has been significant thought put into the possible needs, and when to act on them. The \$19,150 budget for 2024 includes a possible sun shelter on Skier's Island, follow-up work on the shoreline barriers at Sunset Island, goose droppings cleanup, dock install/removal, and other smaller items.



Why we Need to Kick the Fertilizer Habit

Lake Sherwood's beautiful blue waters are changing to shades of green from algae growing on the water. Algae can be toxic making it unsafe for humans and animals, including our pets. One of the contributing factors is the use of fertilizers used in landscaping and the second is the way we are using our outdoor space. Many homeowners have cleared trees and plants to create panoramic views of the lake. As a result, a significant number of properties around Lake Sherwood have no natural buffers to stop excess nutrients from entering the lake. When homes have hardscapes to the lakes edge, nutrients intended for our plants are not absorbed and they flow directly into the water.

Fertilizing your lawn is helping algae to grow in Lake Sherwood

More homeowners have chosen to grow green lawns down to the shore, rather than maintaining a buffer between their lawns and the lake. In addition, an increasing number of homeowners are having contractors fertilize their lawns 4-5 times every year. Stormwater run-off flows across your lawn and carries excess fertilizer directly into the lake or into a ditch, then down the road and into the lake. It also percolates into our groundwater.

There is no such thing as a lake friendly fertilizer

The best way to grow green grass is to build healthy soil, which takes a few years. Healthy soil contains microbes that gradually decompose organic matter (leaves & grass clippings) releasing nutrients gradually, without the need for additional fertilizers.

Chemical fertilizers, derived from petroleum products, add nutrients but do not add anything else to soil. Organic fertilizers, made with natural materials, add

nutrients AND provide food for microbes to build healthy soils. Better organic fertilizers include humus, compost, and peat—which contain microbes. OR just use your own FREE grass clippings.

You can make a difference for the health of Lake Sherwood!

<u>Step 1.</u> Stop fertilizer from leaving your lawn and entering the water. Establish a No Mow Zone or Install a Buffer Garden between the lawn and water. Plants have deeper roots than grass, so they can take up more nutrients.

<u>Step 2.</u> Less lawn means less fertilizer. Shrink your lawn to only the area you need for play, paths and picnics. Rethink your attachment to your lawn. Rewild your property by Planting Trees and Planting Native Shrubs and Flowers.

<u>Step 3</u>. Apply organic fertilizer less often.

<u>Step 4.</u> DONT APPLY FERTILIZERS AT ALL. Grass clippings, and watering with the lake water provides the nutrients and nitrogen that grass needs.

Dear Lake Sherwood Property Owner,

Dues remain at \$400 this year. These Dues cover the period from January 1, 2024 to December 31, 2024. Your Dues pay for maintenance and improvements to the lake itself, as well as the LSA area grounds. The 2024 budget was approved at the October 2023 Annual Membership meeting. The approved Dues for 2024 amount to \$400.00 per lot, the same amount as 2023.

<u>Due date - February 15, 2024</u>. There will be no second notices. Any Dues not paid by March 15, 2024 will have late charges of \$50 applied. As per the By-Laws, the LSA Board of Directors reserves the right to file a lien on any property with unpaid Dues/assessments, and pass the charges on to the member. Further, ramp access to or from the lake will not be given to any homeowner who has not paid their Dues, has not filled out a Boat Ramp User Agreement (not required every year, so if already completed, no need to do another one), and has not provided proof of ownership for all vessels.

<u>Timing</u>: If you want to use the boat ramp in 2024, you need to pay your Dues beforehand. Please allow at least 2 weeks from the time you make your payment until the payment is fully processed by the Association.

<u>No monies collected at the ramp.</u> Your account will need to be paid in advance to gain access to the lake via the electronic gate at the ramp. Each resident will use their ramp access card that will only be activated once all monies owed LSA are **paid in full**.

Electronic payment option. LSA will continue to accept electronic payments in two forms, credit card or ACH, through our bank (PNC Bank). A step-by-step process is available by going to https://www.payerexpress.com/ebp/LakeSherwood/ or go to the Lake Sherwood web page (www.lake-sherwood/ or go to the Lake Sherwood web page (www.lake-sherwood.org). This option will be available any time 24-7. A convenience fee will be charged. If paying by credit card, the total amount due is \$415. If paying by ACH/electronic transfer, the total amount due is \$403. It is your responsibility to pay the appropriate amount on the secured PNC website and ensure funds are available in your account. Any returned item fees will be charged back to you.

<u>Off-water property owners – The A-Lot registration form is attached</u>. Please submit your form to the LSA PO Box or email it to Linda Gepper at lwgepper@gmail.com. (We do accept these forms electronically)

SHRINK-WRAP RECYCLING

The **Recycling Run** program has been the official collection program for boat covers in Michigan for over 10 years and we invite you to join marinas, boat dealers, and individuals across the state in participating – at **No Cost to LSA Residents**.



Since our trash collection company GFL cannot process (for recycling) the thicker plastic used for shrink-wrapping boats, our goal is to reduce the amount of plastic that is currently going into landfills.

The program provides clear plastic bags which are filled with the shrink-wrap from 2 boats and are then taken to Commerce Township Offices which is a newly designated recycling drop-off center.

To make it easier for Lake Sherwood residents to participate in this program, we are offering 2 Options per below

Option #1: You have 2 boats or would like to buddy with a neighbor to fill a bag with 2 shrink-wraps. Text/Call **Nick Polcyn** at 248 863 8410 to arrange for a bag

Option #2: We are offering to collect (receive) individual shrinkwrap and stuff the bags so that residents do not need to look for a partner to fill each bag.

Gary Koch (2978 Ravinewood) is volunteering to use his garage as the drop-off location where bags will be stuffed with the shrink-wrap and filled. Double bags from Option #1 can also be dropped off.

<u>Drop-off will be accepted on Saturday & Sunday's from 11-12 during April/May</u> If you cannot make it on Sat/Sun you can text/call Gary at 248 982 6402 to arrange for an alternate time

This program only accepts the shrink-wrap material – <u>All strapping, plastic vents, fasteners etc. must be removed to enable your</u> <u>shrink-wrap to be accepted.</u>


