Some roads will need replacement (north of Commerce Rd) that involves a Special Assessment District from either Commerce Township or the Road Commission for Oakland County. Other roads will need pot hole repairs (Driftwood/Triwood). *However*, many roads (east of main lake; south of Commerce Rd) can benefit from crack filling as a preventative measure to extend the life of these roads. Such an effort would be paid via a supplemental LSA dues fee that will only be assessed to the homes on the affected streets.
