GUEST BOAT REGISTRATION FORM

This form must be <u>completed</u> at least 3 days in advance of launch and signed by the Boat Ramp Committee of the Lake Sherwood Association to obtain access to the lake for non-resident watercraft. Lake Sherwood resident must be a member in good standing. Hosting members are responsible for ensuring their guests know our lake rules. A guest boat cannot be a watercraft that is owned by another LSA resident who (for any reason) is not a member in good standing. On water residents guest boats must be docked at the sponsor's home for overnight stays. Off water resident guest boats must be docked at the residents A-lot slip or removed and stored on a legally parked trailer at the sponsor's home during any overnight stay. Duration of stay on lake for a guest boat cannot exceed 2 consecutive nights in any 30 day period unless special requests are granted. (surrogate/replacement boats).
